In the evening we depart for the Water Puppet Show, a Vietnamese tradition that dates back to the 11th century. The shows are performed in a waist-deep pool so the puppets appear to be moving over water. <http://thanglongwaterpuppet.com>

DAY THREE – Breakfast at the hotel buffet. Get ready for the Hop on – Hop off city tour of 13 different attractions. Discover the bustling city of Hanoi, boasting a rich cultural heritage with French, Chinese and Southeast Asian influences. DAY FOUR – Breakfast at the hotel buffet. Depart to the airport for a one-and-a-half- hour flight to Da Nang. Arrive at our five-star hotel and get acquainted with your surroundings.

In the evening we depart for the unique fire-breathing Dragon Bridge located on the beautiful Han River. DAY FIVE – Breakfast at the hotel buffet. Depart for Lady Buddha statue. Vietnam’s tallest (17 stories) Buddha statue isn’t your typical male Buddha effigy. There’s more to see at the temple as well. Afterwards we depart for the Marble Mountains, a series of limestone and marble caves containing Buddha and Hindu shrines.
